The successful candidate will be hardworking, enthusiastic individual that want to be part of a warm, welcoming Special School and should have a passion for working with special educational needs and disabilities, which include severe learning difficulties; physical difficulties; profound and multiple learning difficulties; severe autism and challenging behaviours.

The post is part time, working 32.5 hours per week (Monday to Friday), term time only including INSET days.
